


Five-Year Rolling CAGR of As Reported Earnings

Summary of Guidelines

St. Lucie County Fire District Firefighters' Pension Fund

Objective

- To obtain a reasonable total rate of return, commensurate with the Prudent Person Rule. To obtain reasonable consistency of returns judged over a three to five year period. Protection of capital against the erosion of inflation and wide swings in the value of assets.
- Returns are expected to exceed the Russell 1000[®] Growth Index over a three to five year period and rank in the top 40th percentile of an appropriate universe.

Guidelines

- The Benchmark is the Russell 1000® Growth Index.
- A maximum of 5% at market may be invested in any one stock.
- The aggregate investment in any one company shall not exceed 5% of the outstanding stock.
- Up to 25% may be held in foreign stocks and ADR's, as long as traded on a US exchange.
- Do not purchase companies listed as "scrutinized companies" by the FL SBA under the Protecting Florida Investments Act (PFIA).

Trading

• When possible, without sacrificing best net price and execution, trades should be directed to Cowen Execution Services. Per letter dated October 2011.

Proxy Voting

• The manager has sole responsibility for voting proxies of shares of companies in the portfolio.

Compliance

• Atlanta Capital has not made contributions to any candidates/incumbents for the St. Lucie County, City of Fort Pierce or City of Port St. Lucie Commission or Mayor.



Investment Outlook & Strategy

High Quality Growth Plus

Investment Outlook

- The first six months of 2020 have been one for the record books. During the first quarter, large cap equity markets experienced their fastest 30% declines in history, a reaction to the global pandemic not only slowing the economy but shutting it down. During the second quarter, the S&P 500[®] Index posted its best quarter since 1998 and the Russell 1000[®] and Russell 1000[®] Growth posted their best quarters ever.
- Markets often look through weaker environments, but this time, the record stimulus helped to catapult the market. The stimulus flooded into the
 economically sensitive sectors pushing Energy returns up over 40% in the Russell 1000[®] Growth. Consumer Discretionary and Information Technology both
 advanced over 30%. Defensive and interest rate sensitive sectors lagged; Consumer Staples and Utilities were up only 10% and 3%, respectively. Consistent
 with other market rebounds, lower quality stocks led aided by the significant stimulus tailwind.
- Regardless of where we are in the economic cycle our long term investment approach remains the same.
- We will stay focused on the strategy's fundamental, bottom-up stock analysis that seeks to identify high quality businesses that may be able to withstand more volatile environments. Over time, we believe this strategy may help minimize downside risk in more challenging markets, while still allowing participation in better environments.

Portfolio Positioning

- During the quarter, two stocks were added and two were eliminated from the portfolio.
- At quarter end, the portfolio contained 45 stocks diversified across nine sectors.
- Although sector weights are a result of individual stock decisions, relative to the sector weights in the index, the portfolio was overweight Financials, Industrials, Materials and Real Estate.
- The portfolio was underweight Communication Services, Consumer Discretionary, Consumer Staples, and Information Technology. The Health Care sector weight was neutral and there were no Energy or Utility holdings.
